## COMPETITION'S VIDEO SUBMISSION PROCEDURE

- video must be <u>recorded continuously</u>, with stationary camera, stably, preferably horizontally, and no editing is permitted;
- video must include the whole image of the contestant and stage clothing is required;
- contestants are responsible for the video quality;
- the organizers reserve the right not to submit low-quality videos for the jury evaluation;
- video is posted on the youtube channel. The title field must contain full name of the contestant. The audience is for children ("Yes, it is made for kids"). Video is posted as "Unlisted". The competition application must include a reference link to the video.

## **RULES OF THE COMPETITION**

The competition consists of one round. The number of participants to take part at the contest-festival is limited. The time of submission of the applications will be taken into account. In the case of non-entry, the participant's fee will not be refunded. The order of performers will be based on the year of birth.

Please note that changes to the repertoire will not be possible during the contest. You are kindly asked to inform the organizers about the changes in the contestant's repertoire by the 01th of May, 2025, at the latest.

## JURY OF THE COMPETITION

The participants of the contest will be evaluated by the international jury whose names will be announced at the opening of the contest. The decisions of the jury are final and not subject to appeal. The scores of the jury will be publicly announced at the competition sites. The jury has the right to terminate the performance of the participant if it exceeds the set time limit. The jury member does not evaluate the participation of his student.

## **AWARDS**

Contest participants will be awarded laureate diplomas, participant diplomas and prizes. The grand prize (Grand Prix) will be awarded to the participants of each age category who have collected the maximum number of points. Special prizes are awarded for the best performed piece by a Lithuanian, Armenian or national composer in each age category. The final concert of the competition is attended by the jury and the winners selected by the decision of the organizers. Contest organizers have all rights to recordings, radio and TV broadcasts of the contest and final concert without payment to the contestants.

# **FESTIVAL PARTICIPANTS:**

## PIANO AND CHAMBER ENSEMBLES.

Piano ensembles are performed at one piano. The teacher/concertmaster/illustrator can participate in the ensemble as a participant\*.

Chamber ensembles – vocal or instrumental or vocal-instrumental ensemble of various compositions. Up to 6 members can participate in the ensemble. Can participate with teachers/concertmasters/illustrators as participants\*.

# Repertoire

Freely chosen piece(s) up to 5 minutes, one of which must be a **Lithuanian or Armenian piece**, **or a** piece by a national composer of your country.

Participant fee - 26 EUR for each participant.

\*Including teacher/concertmaster/illustrator.

## **Awards**

Each participant of the festival is awarded with a participant's diploma and a souvenir. **Special prizes** are awarded for the best performed piece by a Lithuanian, Armenian or national composer.
